An estimate of the trek

The cost of a pass in Rwanda is between \$1,500 and \$2,500 per head. It greatly depends on the tour conductor and time of visit. If you are on a budget, off seasons can be cheaper. The ticket gives you an hour to meet the mountain gorillas. Discounted prices for Rwanda gorilla trekking safaris are available for the citizens and other EA countries. Foreigners have to pay a larger sum for the visit.

A full-day journey that takes you on a trip to Volcanoes National Park may be around \$1,700 per person. A two-day expedition can start at £1,900. Lastly, a three-day luxurious gorilla trekking safari may be somewhere between \$2,000 to \$5,000 each. The tours come with one animal tracking permit, a private vehicle, an English-speaking guide, food, and lodging.
