

Haridwar



The source of the Yamuna River, Yamunotri is known for its hot springs and the Yamunotri Temple dedicated to the goddess Yamuna.






Devprayag

Uttarkashi


Uttarkashi is a town situated on the banks of the Bhagirathi River. It's known for its temples, ashrams, and scenic beauty.




Guptkashi

Guptkashi is a small town situated on the route to Kedarnath. It's known for the ancient Vishwanath Temple and Ardhanarishvara Temple.








Joshimath





Joshimath is a gateway to Badrinath and is known for its temples and as a base for trekking and mountaineering expeditions.





Chamoli

Rudraprayag is another confluence point where the Alaknanda and Mandakini rivers meet. It's known for its temples and scenic beauty.






Gangotri


The source of the Ganges River, Gangotri is surrounded by snow-capped peaks and offers a serene atmosphere for spiritual reflection.
